

The Fourth of July Tour

West Bend to Green Bay July 2nd, 3rd and 4th, 2011



Our tour will begin on July 2nd at "B A Construction" on the North side of West Bend, 3487 County Hwy D, on the Southwest corner of County Hwy D and US 45. Please arrive at 8:00am on Saturday morning so that we may depart promptly at 8:30am (or feel free to join us along the way).

Parking of trailers and tow vehicles will be permitted in the driveway.

Once underway our route will take us around the West side of Lake Winnebago on some great "Model T Roads" and will include 3 of Wisconsin's "Rustic Roads". Our lunch stop will be in Winneconne at the "Fin 'N' Feather" right on the Wolf River. Their lunch buffet will have something for everyone.



In Green Bay, we will be staying at the Bay Motel and Family Restaurant, less than 1 mile from Lambeau Field. (Please make your reservations soon if you are planning to go.) All rooms are 1st floor and parking is right outside your room. Bring a lawn chair & a cooler & enjoy the "park" in the center of the complex. The convenient on-site restaurant has good food at reasonable prices.

On Sunday we have a reservation for a 9:00am Lambeau Field Stadium Tour, home of your SUPER BOWL CHAMPIONS! (We should arrive there at 8:30am.) It is a guided 1 hour tour and your \$17.00 per person "combo" group rate ticket includes a visit to the Hall Of Fame afterwards. This is the only fee that we are asking you to pay in advance, as we must pay in advance for the tour. Following our Hall of Fame visit we will have lunch at Curly's Pub in the Lambeau Field Atrium.





After our Lambeau Field experience, we will have a leisurely afternoon tour that will take us to a couple of interesting shopping destinations. Our first stop will be at Seroogy's Chocolates and their next door neighbor the Spice & Tea Exchange. Then on to the nation's largest kitchen store, Cooks Corner where you can browse their giant gadget wall. A short drive just east of town will find us at Fonferek Glen where we can see a waterfall and a natural bridge accessible by a ½ mile trail. Our trip back into Green Bay will take us to Zesty's Frozen Custard & Grill for dessert, dinner or both!

On Monday we will make our way back to West Bend along the East side of Lake Winnebago. We will stop for a picnic lunch at Larry & Carol Lamont's place in Malone.
