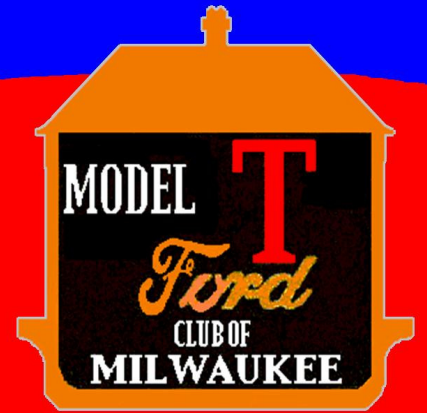

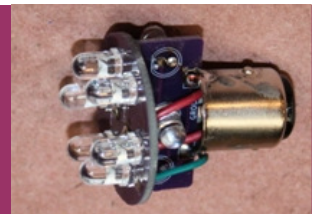
Model T University
